

**PUBLIC NOTICE TO ALL CUSTOMERS OF THE  
CUMBERLAND MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC UTILITY**

Cumberland Municipal Electric Utility has filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) to decrease electric rates.

The total decrease in electric revenues authorized is \$63,900 annually, or 1.6%. Customers in each of the following rate classes will see the following decreases effective October 1, 2013:

Residential Service	-0.3%
General Service	-2.1%
Small Power Service	-2.3%
Large Power Service	-2.1%
Lighting Service	-0.2%

Because no rates were increased as a result of the Public Service Commission's staff proposal, and Cumberland Municipal Utility has accepted the Commission staff's proposed revenue requirement and rate design, a hearing is not required and no hearing was held.
